Local Temporary Evacuation Point

Local Temporary Evacuation Points are nearby locations where people gather after disasters to check on the safety of neighbors, learn the extent of damage, conduct small-scale firefighting duties, and obtain evacuation guidance.

Temporary Evacuation Point.

Precautions

- Travel on foot and take the minimum required materials Travel on wider streets/paths, and
- avoid potential hazards such as concrete-block walls, gate posts, and tall objects/structures which may fall.

Upon Reaching the Local Temporary Evacuation Point

Check the damage conditions and people's safety.


- For daily necessities, use your own items brought to emergency situations before using shelter supplies.

- houses/buildings. • Obtain accurate information, and be prepared for aftershocks.




Measures to Protect Yourself from **Falling Furniture and Other Items**





Check your evacuation route to get to above evacuation sites.


